The Dean of the Augusto Motta University Center - UNISUAM, in the use of his statutory attributions and other general provisions, approves and makes public this Notice, communicating that it will be open in the period of <u>October 29, 2021, to November 24, 2021</u>, registrations for the Application Process for entry into the Graduate Program in Rehabilitation Sciences - PPGCR, based on the regulatory provisions, Law No. 9,394/96, Decree No. 9235/17 and all current legislation.

4. RESEARCH PROPOSAL

- **4.1.** Approved candidates will be able to conduct research projects following the Concentration Area and Research Lines described in this Notice.
- **4.2.** Research projects must follow the United Nations <u>2030 Agenda</u> for Sustainable Development, primarily in Goal #3 "Good health and well-being".
- **4.3.** Projects with adherence to the Ministry of Health's Research Priorities Agenda will receive priority.



4.4. The Research Project consists of a structured document containing: Presentation (cover, candidate identification data, ORCID registration), Abstract in Portuguese (up to 250 words), Abstract in English (up to 250 words), Literature Review (research problem, theoretical-conceptual background within the area of concentration and line of research), Justification (originality, relevance), Objectives, Methods and Participants (design, samples, procedures), Feasibility (funding, co-participating institutions, research collaboration), Impact (social, educational, economic and/or technological), Chronogram (up to 12 months), and References, up to 15 (fifteen) pages.

WORK PLAN

- **5.1.** The Work Plan consists of a structured document containing: Teaching activities (PPGCR courses to be taught), Orientation activities (number of students per course level Master, Doctorate), Scientific activities and knowledge dissemination (expected intellectual production, participation in events in the area), other relevant activities, totaling at most 2 (two) pages.
- **5.2.** The Work Plan must provide for activities in item 4.4.1 for a maximum period of 12 (twelve) months, which may be extended for a total period of no more than 24 (twenty-four) months.
- **5.3.** The designation of the supervisor will be based on the adherence of the respective project to the research field, conditioned to the existence of positions for supervision. In the event of approval by the candidate, the decision to develop the project or not will be made by the supervisor.

8. PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

- **8.1.** The application process will be regulated by this Notice and executed by the Head of Department.
- **8.2.** When completing the application dealt within this Notice, the candidate declares (a) that he/she has read and understood all the terms and conditions of this Notice; (b) accepts all regulations relevant to the event; (c) undertakes to take note of any rectifications, additions, additive terms or notices that may be published on the UNISUAM website, of which you cannot claim ignorance.
- **8.3.** Entries will be made online, according to **item 8** of this Notice.



- **8.4.** All stages of the application process will be carried out online, by videoconference, using the Google Meet communication platform, whose access link will be sent to the candidate's e-mail.
- **8.5.** The research project and work plan activities will be carried out at the Bonsucesso Campus, as determined by the Centro Universitário Augusto Motta UNISUAM.

9. REGISTRATION

- **9.3.** The information provided is the sole responsibility of the candidate, the Head of Department having the right to exclude from the application process the candidate who provides documentation incomplete or proven untrue.
- **9.4.** The absence of any of the requested documents/procedures, as well as their late receipt will disqualify the application.
- **9.5.** The application for registration in this notice will be automatically rejected in the following cases: (a) Absence of any of the documents/procedures requested in this Notice; or (b) receipt of the application after the stipulated period.

10. APPLICATION AND CLASSIFICATION PROCESSES

10.1. The application process dealt with in this Notice will consist of 2 (two) phases, the first being eliminatory and the second classifying.

10.2. From the First Phase: ELIMINATORY, with the following structure:

- **10.4.** To be approved in the elimination phase, the candidate must obtain at least 7.0 (seven) points, being disapproved of the application process if he obtains less than 7.0 (seven) points in the elimination phase.
- **10.5.** Only candidates approved in the first phase will do the interview.
- **10.6. Second Phase:** CLASSIFICATORY, with the following structure:

10.8. For candidates with the same total points in the second phase, the tie will be broken through the points obtained in the Lattes Curriculum; if the tie persists, priority will be given to the oldest candidate.



11. ACCREDITATIONS

- **11.1.** Candidates approved and classified up to the limit of positions offered will be entitled to accredit obeying the deadlines and rules set out in this Notice.
- **11.2.** Graduation Diploma holders, Master's and/or Doctorate issued by Foreign Education Institution only will be able to register after being recognized in the country, in accordance with current legislation.
- **11.3.** Lasting the determinations of the Public Power for social isolation during the period of activities, these will be fulfilled remotely, by sending documents to the email informed by the candidate at the time of registration.

12. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- **12.1.** This application process is valid only for the accreditations made for the academic semester indicated in this Notice.
- **12.2.** Under no pretext, there will be a second call for the tests and interviews, as well as no view or proof of proof will be granted in this application process.
- **12.3.** Candidates who fail to enroll in the deadline set in this Notice will be considered a dropout, regardless of the reason. If there are vacancies remaining, approved candidates may be reclassified, but not classified, according to the limit of vacancies.
- **12.4.** The documentation sent from not classified candidates will be discarded 1 (one) day after the registration deadline stipulated in this Notice.
- **12.5.** The Research, Extension and Innovation Directorate will be able to carry out additional instructions for the application of this application process and, for enrollments, will decide on the omitted cases, upon prior notice to the candidates.
- **12.6.** Omissions and situations not provided for in this Notice will be evaluated by the Program Coordination and forwarded to the Dean of Research, Extension, and Innovation of the Centro Universitário Augusto Motta.
